### **Comprehension Strategies**

Last week Miss Hounsell asked the Year 2 –Year 5 students to write thick and thin questions to develop their comprehension strategies. Thick questions deal with large concepts or big ideas in a text while thin questions deal with specific words or information in a text. After watching a video relating to their unit on Multiculturalism, each student had to go and write a thick and a thin question. Students then had to sit in the 'Hot Seat' and were asked questions by their peers. Firstly they had to identify whether it was a thick or a thin question then answer the questions based on their understanding of the video.

The primary students have also been publishing reports on how Bike helmets are made and the importance of having correctly fitting bike helmets.
