




Life Education Van

Last Monday we had a fun filled learning day with Happy Harold from the Life Education Van. We joined Brocklesby students in learning about the many different topics that keep us safe and healthy.

The Kindergarten and Year 1 students learnt about the benefits of including a nutritious diet, physical activity and how our body reacts in new situations. Students in Years 2 and 3 had an informative session on the functions of various body organs such as the heart, lung, brain and kidneys. They also explored ways to manage peer pressure and the importance of exercise and healthy choices. Years 5 and 6 focussed on improving their decision making by looking at choices, consequences, peer influences, cyber safety and cyber ethics.
