We are looking forward to seeing our community grow in size on Sunday 5th August as the carnival takes place!

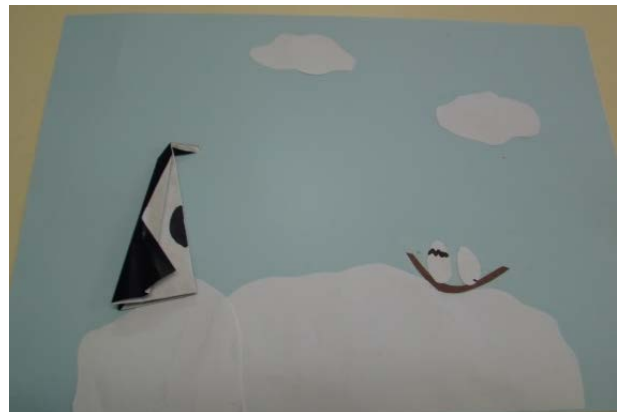
Class News
