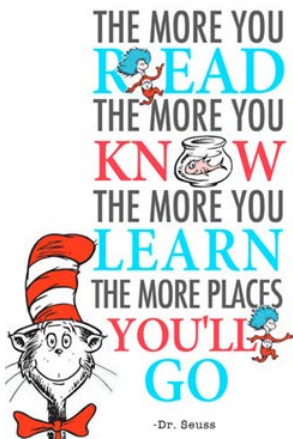

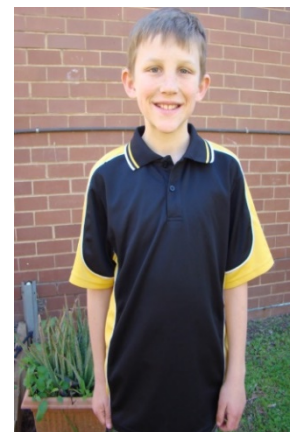
Soccer with Sam
